For ages 13 years and up

Coastal Dance Centre's **ADVANCED BALLET INTENSIVE** is for students ages **13 years and older / current Ballet Levels 7 and Advanced**, who have had a minimum of five (5) years of serious ballet technique training, (*not counting preschool dance*), currently taking dance classes and seriously thriving during the long days in the studio. This intensive is for students who are wanting to immerse themselves in rigorous dance training this summer and demonstrates a high level of achievement, talent, and potential.

Daily classes include Ballet Technique, Pre-Pointe/Pointe, * Variations, and Repertoire. These intensive will be taught by Coastal Dance Centre faculty and guest master teachers.

What is a Variations Class?

The Variations class will focus on the study of solo repertoire from classical ballets. The study of variations is an effective means of linking the vocabulary taught in ballet technique classes to its application in performance. This class provides tremendous valuable experience for students as they learn and practice a professional level solo variation.

What is a Repertoire Class?

Repertoire focuses on learning the skills required to work in an ensemble/group. It provides a tremendously valuable experience for students as they practice and prepare to work on classical and contemporary ensemble repertoire.

These Summer Intensive programs are also a pathway to prepare new students who wish to join the 2023-2024 Coastal Dance Centre's Conservatory Program.

Performance Opportunity

The **ADVANCED INTENSIVE** will culminate in a **Summer Showcase Performance on Saturday, August 5**, featuring variations and repertoire learned in the Intensive. Students must attend **all 3 weeks of the summer intensive** to be in the Summer Showcase Performance. Students attending only a week or two of the summer intensive are not eligible to participate in the Summer Showcase.

*** All three weeks of the summer intensive are required for prospective 2023-2024 Junior Conservatory and Elite Conservatory Students.**

Advanced Ballet Intensive Fees:

For the Summer Intensive Program, Coastal Dance Centre offers Payment Plan Options. All Intensive registrants will be required to be on payment plans unless paying in full. The non-refundable and non-transferrable Deposit and Registration fees are due at the time of registration to reserve the student's place in the program.

Coastal Dance Centre 2023 Summer Intensive Information

1) What is the age requirement for students applying?

Students from age 9 years and up are invited to apply and attend the Coastal Dance Centre Summer 2023 Intensive. Students will be placed/assigned according to age, ability, and skill level.

2) How are new students accepted into the Coastal Dance Centre (CDC) Intensive?

Acceptance into Coastal Dance Centre's Summer Intensive Program begins with the Application / Audition / Placement Process.

Complete the Audition Application Form.

*** Currently enrolled Coastal Dance Centre students will be placed internally by CDC faculty and do not have to audition.**

3) How does one audition?

Attend an In-Person Audition:

Sign-up to attend an In-Person Audition Class on Saturday, April 29th or May 13th

For students outside the Myrtle Beach area:

Complete the Audition Application Form and submit the requested photos & video as listed in the Audition Application Form

4) What is the audition attire?

Ladies: Leotard, pink tights, ballet shoes (*bring pointe shoes for those studying Pointe*). Pointe work may be given during the last 20 minutes of the audition class.

Gentlemen: Appropriate ballet class attire that the dancer will be comfortable in.

5) Is there an audition fee?

Yes, there is an In-Person Audition Fee of **\$35.00**.

6) What do I do if I cannot make it to the audition dates listed above?

Audition videos are also accepted. There is a Video Audition Fee of **\$35.00**

7) What are the requirements for auditioning by video?

Requirements for auditioning by video:

- * Total length: No longer than 10 minutes
- * Auditioning dancer should be easily identifiable in the video.

AT THE BARRE

- * Plies
- * Tendu
- * Fondu
- * Développé
- * Grands battements: each front, side and back

Note: Show one of each in all directions, however both sides of each combination are not necessary, please show combinations on alternate sides), all shot in profile.

IN THE CENTER

- * Pirouettes en dedans and en dehors
- * Small jumps
- * The following steps in one or two combinations:
 - Sissone, Glissade, Assemblé, Jeté

Note: All done facing the camera except for those steps which move naturally across the floor.

ACROSS THE FLOOR

Tour jeté

Grand jeté

A waltzing grand allegro

Note: Only very short combinations needed.

Pointe work –

At the barre: relevés in arabesque on the right foot and then the left (shown in profile).

IN THE CENTER

Échappé combination

Pirouettes

Gentlemen: Please also include: tour en l'air and entrechat; à la seconde turns.

NOTE: Each audition video must be prepared in accordance with Coastal Dance Centre's specifications and submitted with a non-refundable \$35 video audition fee. Videos will not be reviewed without submission of payment.

8) When will I be notified of application results?

All applicants will be notified of their acceptance results via email approximately one week, but no later than two weeks following acceptance of your application.

9) How are students placed into their levels at the Coastal Dance Centre (CDC) Summer Intensive?

Level placement will depend on age and technical ability.

10) If I am accepted, may I attend only part of the Summer Intensive?

Coastal Dance Centre highly encourages that summer students be enrolled for the entire week / two- or three-week program.

11) Is there a student performance at the end of the Summer Intensive?

Students in the 3-week program will be able to participate in the Summer Showcase. The performance is on **Saturday, August 5**.

12) I have been accepted into the program. What should I do now?

If you have been accepted into the program, please register online through our Parent Portal and the required deposit must be submitted to guarantee your spot. Registrations are accepted on a first come, first served basis.

13) When are the deposits due?

The non-refundable and non-transferable deposit is due at the time of Registration.

14) Do deposits go towards tuition?

Yes, your non-refundable deposit will count towards the total balance. Credit Card payments over the phone can also be accepted for a deposit. All deposits are non-refundable, no exceptions.

15) Do you offer a Payment Plan Option?

Yes. If you wish to avail of the Payment Plan options.

16) Can I get a refund? What is your refund policy?

Tuition is non-refundable and non-transferable. Participants who must withdraw due to injury or illness **before** the Summer Intensive Program starts will receive a tuition refund minus a 15% administrative fee subject to the receipt of a medical certificate or a doctor's note. **No refunds without a doctor's note.**

17) Right to Refuse Service

Coastal Dance Centre reserves the right to exclude or refuse service to any person at any time prior to or during the Summer Intensive Program, if in the opinion of Coastal Dance Centre's staff, that person is incompatible with the general enjoyment and well-being of the event. In this instance, no refund will be given.

18) Do you have lodging arrangements for out-of-town students attending the Summer Intensive?

Currently, we do not have any housing available. Families of out-of-town students are responsible for finding housing accommodations and transportation to and from Coastal Dance Centre will have to find a place to stay during the intensive. Please note that we are not responsible for supervising these students outside of the dance studios.

ELITE CONSERVATORY and JUNIOR CONSERVATORY PROGRAM**

COASTAL DANCE CENTRE'S ELITE AND JUNIOR CONSERVATORY PROGRAM is for dancers, ages 9–16 years. This program is for students who are highly motivated, passionate, and committed to doing hard work. It is for those who demonstrate a high level of achievement, talent, and potential.

Acceptance to the Elite Conservatory and Junior Conservatory Program is by invitation only. We are highly selective and would only want to invest our time and effort to work with dancers who are willing to do the required training, the required attendance, and who will commit to train consistently and be supported one hundred per cent by their parents and family members.

The 2023 Summer Dance Training is an audition leading to the membership of the year-round program.

Dancers who are in the Elite and Junior Conservatory Program automatically become members of Coastal Dance Centre's performing company, the Coastal Youth Ballet Theatre.

Elite and Junior Conservatory dancers are expected to be committed to training and competing at a level of excellence. Elite and Junior Conservatory dancers must first be an ensemble member.

At the Artistic Directors' discretion, those who want to have a one-on-one learning and growing experience with the teacher/coach may be given the opportunity to learn and prepare a classical and contemporary solo variation for competitions such as the Youth America Grand Prix.

Elite and Junior Conservatory dancers are required to sign a contract that confirms their commitment to both the fees and training required to perform at an elite level.

ELITE CONSERVATORY and JUNIOR CONSERVATORY PROGRAM**

Elite and Junior Conservatory dancers are dedicated via the contract to exclusive training at Coastal Dance Centre.

Elite and Junior Conservatory dancers train for more hours than others at the dance school, taking both mandatory technique classes in several disciplines such as ballet, jazz, tap, acrobatics, and contemporary/lyrical. On top of this, they attend ensemble rehearsals that are necessary to learn and rehearse for the performing company's performances and the dance competitions.

During the year, they will attend several competitions and may travel regionally (and nationally, if they qualify).

To ensure commitment and focus to the dance program, Elite and Junior Conservatory dancers are expected to not commit to outside sports and other extracurricular activities.

There are higher expectations for the Elite and Junior Conservatory dancers since they are representative of the quality of training at Coastal Dance Centre and as such, they help enhance the reputation of the school.
