## **What is a Summer Dance Intensive?**

The idea behind a summer dance intensive is to provide a rigorous period of dance training typically held as a multi-week program during the summer months.

The dancer will spend days immersed in dance, receiving instruction, corrections, and valuable feedback from the teachers, gaining strength, and training alongside other dancers.

### **How do summer dance intensives benefit dancers?**

Summer training is an exciting and crucial part of any serious dancer's progress.

Attending summer dance intensives allows students to hone their skills as a dancer. Students will gain physical strength, flexibility and muscle memory while improving their technique, artistic potential, and performance skills. Students will be working very hard, all day, every day!

Strength, flexibility, and technique improve in a very short period of time.

#### Summer dance intensives is about growth.

It is not just the quality of instruction that makes a summer dance intensive so beneficial for students. The structure and time spent in rigorous training also leads to growth. Summer dance intensive students are immersed in dance nearly full time, attending several classes per day.

Taking advantage of the whole summer of intensives could result in a year's worth of progress in a dancer's technique and artistry!

Think it sounds rigorous? Indeed, it is!

#### Performance opportunity at the end of the Intensives

A student who attends the entire summer intensive weeks will also have a performance opportunity at the end of the intensives. Performing in and observing other dancers in an instructional setting helps expand a dancer's knowledge and understanding of dance, and hopefully, will inspire the dancers to set goals for their future in dance.

It is for these reasons and more that the summer dance intensive has become such a valuable tool in so many serious dancers' education and training.

It is a rite of passage for serious-minded dancers.

The best way, however, to really understand what a summer dance intensive is and how it can benefit the student is to attend and experience one yourself.

For the older students (14 years and up) who attend summer intensives away from home, a dancer will probably also experience some growing up because there is travel and living away from home involved.

A summer dance intensive away from home is many older dancers' first experience living away from home for an extended period. While our local dancers may commute from home, those who are from another town or state will have to travel and must arrange for accommodations such as Airbnb, or with maybe for some, stay with host families, often for weeks at a time. Students who stay with host families are chaperoned. It is somewhat like being in college, students live semi-independently. These few weeks of relative independence and rigorous study lead to personal growth. For dancers who live and study with other students who are also host families and who are passionate about dance, this opportunity may lead to life-long friendships. And it all happens in just a few weeks' time!

## **THE JUNIOR BALLET INTENSIVE**

For Ages 9 – 14 years

Venue: Coastal Dance Centre Studio, 3073 Howard Avenue, Myrtle Beach, SC

The **JUNIOR BALLET INTENSIVE** is designed for students ages **9 – 14 years**, who have had a minimum of 3 – 4 years of serious ballet technique training (not including preschool dance classes), wishing to immerse themselves in rigorous ballet training this summer.

Daily classes will include ballet technique, character, repertoire, and variations coaching.

Classes will be taught by Coastal Dance Centre Faculty.

#### What is a Repertoire Class?

Repertoire focuses on learning the skills required to work in an ensemble/group. It provides a tremendously valuable experience for students as they practice and prepare to work on classical and contemporary ensemble repertoire.

#### What is a Character Dance Class?

Character dance is the theatrical presentation of National dances using original folk dance and music which has been freely adapted for the theatre. The dances studied by students provide an opportunity to learn the roots of classical ballet and to develop the skills necessary for working with partners and in large groups.

Students in a Character class wear a special canvas shoe with a small / Cuban heel.

This Summer Intensive program is also recommended as a pathway to prepare new students who wish to join the 2023-2024 Coastal Dance Centre's Conservatory Program.

#### 1) What is the age requirement for students applying?

Acceptance into Coastal Dance Centre's Summer Intensive Program begins with the Application / Audition / Placement Process.

#### Complete the Audition Application Form.

\* Currently enrolled Coastal Dance Centre students will be placed internally by CDC faculty and do not have to audition.

#### 3) How does one audition?

#### **Attend an In-Person Audition:**

#### For students outside the Myrtle Beach area:

Complete the Audition Application Form and submit the requested photos & video as listed in the Audition Application Form

#### 4) What is the audition attire?

**Ladies:** Leotard, pink tights, ballet shoes (*bring pointe shoes for those studying Pointe*). Pointe work may be given during the last 20 minutes of the audition class.

Gentlemen: Appropriate ballet class attire that the dancer will be comfortable in.

#### 5) Is there an audition fee?

Yes, there is an In-Person Audition Fee of \$35.00.

#### 6) What do I do if I cannot make it to the audition dates listed above?

Audition videos are also accepted. There is a Video Audition Fee of \$35.00

#### 7) What are the requirements for auditioning by video?

#### Requirements for auditioning by video:

- \* Total length: No longer than 10 minutes
- \* Auditioning dancer should be easily identifiable in the video.

#### **AT THE BARRE**

- \* Plies
- \* Tendu
- \* Fondu
- \* Développé
- \* Grands battements: each front, side and back

**Note:** Show one of each in all directions, however both sides of each combination are not necessary, please show combinations on alternate sides), all shot in profile.

#### **IN THE CENTER**

- \* Pirouettes en dedans and en dehors
- \* Small jumps
- \* The following steps in one or two combinations:
- Sissone, Glissade, Assemblé, Jeté

Note: All done facing the camera except for those steps which move naturally across the floor.

#### **ACROSS THE FLOOR**

Tour jeté

Grand jeté

A waltzing grand allegro

Note: Only very short combinations needed.

#### Pointe work -

At the barre: rélevès in arabesque on the right foot and then the left (shown in profile).

#### IN THE CENTER

Échappé combination

**Pirouettes** 

Gentlemen: Please also include: tour en l'air and entrechat; à la seconde turns.

**NOTE:** Each audition video must be prepared in accordance with Coastal Dance Centre's specifications and submitted with a non-refundable \$35 video audition fee. Videos will not be reviewed without submission of payment.

#### 8) When will I be notified of application results?

All applicants will be notified of their acceptance results via email approximately one week, but no later than two weeks following acceptance of your application.

## 9) How are students placed into their levels at the Coastal Dance Centre (CDC) Summer Intensives?

Level placement will depend on age and technical ability.

#### 10) If I am accepted, may I attend only part of the Summer Intensives?

Coastal Dance Centre highly encourages that summer students be enrolled for the entire week / two- or three-week program.

#### 11) Is there a student performance at the end of the Summer Intensives?

Students in the 3-week program will be able to participate in the Summer Showcase. The performance is on <u>Saturday</u>, <u>August 5</u>.

#### 12) I have been accepted into the program. What should I do now?

If you have been accepted into the program, please register online through our Parent Portal and the required deposit must be submitted to guarantee your spot. Registrations are accepted on a first come, first served basis.

## 13) When are the deposits due?

The non-refundable and non-transferable deposit is due at the time of Registration.

#### 14) Do deposits go towards tuition?

Yes, your non-refundable deposit will count towards the total balance. Credit Card payments over the phone can also be accepted for a deposit. All deposits are non-refundable, no exceptions.

## 15) Do you offer a Payment Plan Option?

## 16) Can I get a refund? What is your refund policy?

coastal dance centre's elite and Junior conservatory program is for dancers, ages 9–16 years. This program is for students who are highly motivated, passionate, and committed to doing hard work. It is for those who demonstrate a high level of achievement, talent, and potential.

Acceptance to the Elite Conservatory and Junior Conservatory Program is by invitation only. We are highly selective and would only want to invest our time and effort to work with dancers who are willing to do the required training, the required attendance, and who will commit to train consistently and be supported one hundred per cent by their parents and family members.

The 2023 Summer Dance Training is an audition leading to the membership of the year-round program.

Dancers who are in the Elite and Junior Conservatory Program automatically become members of Coastal Dance Centre's performing company, the Coastal Youth Ballet Theatre.

Elite and Junior Conservatory dancers are expected to be committed to training and competing at a level of excellence. Elite and Junior Conservatory dancers must first be an ensemble member.

At the Artistic Directors' discretion, those who want to have a one-on-one learning and growing experience with the teacher/coach may be given the opportunity to learn and prepare a classical and contemporary solo variation for competitions such as the Youth America Grand Prix.

Elite and Junior Conservatory dancers are required to sign a contract that confirms their commitment to both the fees and training required to perform at an elite level.

## COASTAL DANCE CENTRE'S ELITE CONSERVATORY and JUNIOR CONSERVATORY PROGRAM

Elite and Junior Conservatory dancers are dedicated via the contract to exclusive training at Coastal Dance Centre.

Elite and Junior Conservatory dancers train for more hours than others at the dance school, taking both mandatory technique classes in several disciplines such as ballet, jazz, tap, acrobatics, and contemporary/lyrical. On top of this, they attend ensemble rehearsals that are necessary to learn and rehearse for the performing company's performances and the dance competitions.

During the year, they will attend several competitions and may travel regionally (and nationally, if they qualify).

To ensure commitment and focus to the dance program, Elite and Junior Conservatory dancers are expected to not commit to outside sports and other extracurricular activities.

There are higher expectations for the Elite and Junior Conservatory dancers since they are representative of the quality of training at Coastal Dance Centre and as such, they help enhance the reputation of the school.
